BURLINGTON, N.J.

► Located in Burlington, N.J., the new multi-story Burlington Coat Factory Corporate Headquarters facility is being built on 50 acres of undeveloped land and will house more than 800 employees. When complete, the corporate building will create 120 new full-time jobs, while maintaining more than 600 existing positions. General contractor Barr & Barr, Inc. of New York, N.Y. chose Madison Concrete for their extensive experience in commercial concrete buildings.

Construction on the new facility began in 2013. The 215,100-square-foot building consists

of almost 5,000 cubic yards of concrete for the footings and foundation system, along with approximately 200,000 square feet of flatwork. To ensure the project was delivered on time, Madison poured nearly 30 feet of 15-foot-high concrete foundation walls per day. The challenge was working around the amount of brick shelf and embedded materials in each pour. In addition, tarps and heaters were required during the winter months to pour the slabs on the metal deck.

The headquarters is scheduled to be completed in July 2014.
